- Floss once a day to remove plaque in between teeth
- Change your toothbrush every 3 months

Become a prevention practice and see the impact that you can have through engaging with your local community.

- Be a positive role model for children, parents, carers and other professionals and make going to the dentist a positive experience
- Engaging with your local community outside the dental setting, can build your patient base- creating a referral pathway for prevention and treatment access

- Have the BSBF colouring sheets and Bright Smiles Heroes Journey Maze available for children whilst they wait
- Play the Adventures in the Molar System video on waiting room monitor
- Get creative and set up your own space-themed area, where children can be transported into the Molar System as they prepare to embark on their oral care mission!

Concluding the Visit

- Reward children with a **certificate of achievement and/or sticke**rs
- Give a family take home brochure with brushing chart to reinforce good behaviour and emphasise a bedtime routine that includes brushing the child's teeth with fluoride toothpaste
